**Major Alberto MartinezDiaz A.**

Major MartinezDiaz serves as the Deputy Comptroller for the 12<sup>th</sup> Marine Corps District. He was born in Sinaloa, Mexico on 15 November 1970 and grew up in Orange, California. He Enlisted in the Marine Corps in November 1990 as an Aviation Supply Database Operator.

While enlisted, he served with Marine Aviation Logistics (MALS) 11 at El Toro, California from Aug 1991 to Dec 1993. In January 1994 he was transferred to MALS-12 in Iwakuni, Japan. On August 1994 then Cpl MartinezDiaz separated from active duty to pursue a degree in Criminal Justice. Immediately upon his separation from active duty, he joined the active reserves and was assigned to MALS-46 at El Toro, California.

He graduated from Cal State University Fullerton 1998 and was commissioned a Second Lieutenant through the Platoon Leader's Course—completing Officer Candidate School during his junior year in the summer of 1997.

Upon completing The Basic School and Officer Financial Management School he was assigned to the 1<sup>st</sup> Force Service Support Group (FSSG), Disbursing Office, Camp Pendleton, California where he served as a Deputy Disbursing Officer. He was promoted to First Lieutenant in August 2000. He was transferred in 2001 to the 1st FSSG Command Element for duty as the Deputy. In March 2001 he was selected and frocked to the rank of Captain.

In February 2002 he was selected for the Special Education Program at the Naval Post Graduate School, Monterey, California. In December 2003 he graduated from Naval Post Graduate School (NPS) with a Masters of Business Administration.

Upon his graduation from NPS, he was assigned to the Programs and Resources Department at the Pentagon, Headquarters Marine Corps as a Defense System Analyst. In January 2005, he was selected to serve with Multi-National Forces, Baghdad, Iraq as a Budget Analyst. He deployed to Iraq from January 2005 to August 2005.

In January 2007, then Capt MartinezDiaz, was reassigned as the Resource Evaluation and Analysis (RE&A) Officer, I MEF Headquarters, Camp Pendleton California. While at I MEF, he was selected to deploy from October 2007 to October 2008 with the 7<sup>th</sup> Iraq Infantry Division Military Transition Team (MTT) 0700 as the G-1/G-8 Advisor. In Oct 2008 he was promoted to the rank of Major.

He report to his current assignment at 12th Marine Corps District in June 2009 as the Deputy Comptroller. He assumed command of the 12<sup>th</sup> Marine Corps District, Headquarters Company from Aug 2009 to April 2010.

His personal decorations include Joint Service Commendation Medal, the Navy and Marine Commendation Medal (with Gold Star).
