**Deputy Chief, Enforcement Division**

Lieutenant Moore currently serves as the Deputy Chief of the Enforcement Division at Coast Guard Sector New York. He coordinates daily Ports, Waterways and Coastal Security, Living Marine Resources, Maritime Law Enforcement and Ice Breaking operations. He provides support for three multi-mission small boat stations, two patrol boats, five ice-breaking cutters and deployed units. He assists and advises the Sector Commander, Response Department Chief and other divisions in meeting mission objectives as well as leading, managing, and supervising operations and personnel. Lieutenant Moore reported to Sector New York in June of 2008.

Lieutenant Moore enlisted in the U.S. Coast Guard in 1995. A 2003 graduate of the U.S. Coast Guard's Officer Candidate School and a former second class petty officer, he has served over 14 years in an array of operational and administrative units. His previous officer assignments include Administrative Officer, Office of Congressional and Governmental Affairs, Washington, D. C. and Waterside Security Section and Explosive Detection Canine Team Leader, Maritime Safety and Security Team Kings Bay, Georgia.

Lieutenant Moore's enlisted assignments include serving as a Food Service Specialist onboard the Coast Guard Cutters HORNBEAM, FARALLON, SLEDGE and Integrated Support Command in Miami, Florida. He also served as a Boat Crew and Boarding Team member at Coast Guard Stations Atlantic City and Great Egg, both in southern New Jersey.

Lieutenant Moore is a 2003 graduate of American InterContinental University, holding a Bachelor of Information Technology. He also obtained his Master of Science in Quality Systems Management from the National Graduate School in Falmouth, Massachusetts in 2005.

Lieutenant Moore's decorations include three Coast Guard Achievement Medals, and numerous unit awards and citations.
