<u>MEDICAL SERVICE CORPS (2305)</u>	Complete 20 years active commissioned service by age 60. Waivers may be considered for some specialties that are routinely hard to recruit. All questions regarding age waivers should be directed to Program Manager.	M/F US	Varies with specialty. The only subspecialties not requiring Master's or Ph.D. are Dietetics, Industrial Hygiene, Med Technology, Occ Therapy, Pharmacy, Physical Therapy, PA, and Rad Health. However, most of above require specific certification and/or licensure.
