free Rodeo Express Shuttle buses: Buses will run from four locations throughout the Houston area. Armed Forces Appreciation Committee guests are invited to park and ride free from one of the convenient locations and shuttle to NRG Park.

free admission: Actively serving service members in uniform with military ID, their spouses, and their children under age 18 showing military ID at any NRG Park ticket window will receive free passes to enter the grounds. Once inside, please proceed to The Hideout to pick up tickets for the evening's RODEOHOUSTON performance, tickets are limited and given on a first come first serve basis.

mutton bustin': Children ages 5 to 6 years as of March 4, 2020; who weigh less than 55 pounds; and whose parent is actively-serving, a reservist, or a wounded veteran, will have an opportunity to participate in mutton bustin' at the Junction area between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m., on a first-come, first-served basis, while tickets last.

accessible/handicap NRG Park parking: All parking (accessible and handicap included) located on NRG Park Grounds requires a fee. Parking located on the south end of NRG Stadium off Westridge; there are about 100 permanent places. In the south Kirby parking lot are an additional 250-plus spaces dedicated to handicap parking. These spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis. The Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo™ will provide golf cart and tram service on the grounds to assist the public. All Rodeo Express park and ride locations have accessible parking.

off-site accessible and handicap parking: Each off-site parking lot is handicap accessible. Motorized wheelchairs requiring a lift can be accommodated only at the Reed Road and OST parking lots after 5 p.m.
