CAPT ALBERT ANGEL

Captain Angel is a native of Southern California and a 1994 graduate of the US Naval Academy. He also holds an M.S. from the US Army War College and a Space Systems Certificate from the Naval Postgraduate School. In 2016 he completed the Emerging Leaders Executive course at Harvard and in 2018 completed a National Security Fellowship at MIT's Center for International Studies. He is currently with the **Office of the Naval Inspector General** as Assistant Director for Intel Oversight and Executive Secretary for the Navy's Sensitive Activities Review Group.

Upon completing Surface Warfare Officer School, Captain Angel completed tours aboard USS MCINERENY (FFG 8) and USS PENSACOLA (LSD 36); he participated in three trans-Atlantic



deployments, including JOINT GUARDIAN, ALLIED FORCE and counter drug operations. After transitioning into Naval Intelligence, he served with US Southern Command, followed by a milestone tour as Senior Intelligence Officer (SIO) onboard USS BOXER (LHD 4), where he conducted two short-notice surge deployments in support of *OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM II* and OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM (OEF). He was then assigned to NATO Component **Command Maritime** in Naples, Italy, where he stood up the OPINTEL Maritime Branch, providing intelligence support to deployed assets in support of *OPERATION ACTIVE ENDEAVOUR*, NATO's sole maritime counter-terrorism mission and *OPERATION ALLIED PROVIDER*, NATO's 1st counter-piracy operation. In 2008 he deployed to Afghanistan overseeing intelligence production for all five regional teams in support of NATO's International Security Assistance Force. He next served as Executive Officer (XO) at the Navy Information Operation Command **Texas**, a 575-member intelligence organization conducting signals intelligence, computer network operations, and electronic warfare support. In 2012, he reported back to sea as SIO onboard USS NIMITZ (CVN 68), where he led 120 intelligence professionals during an extended combat deployment in support of *OEF* and crisis response options in North Korea and Syria. He next served as XO at HOPPER Information Services Center, Office of Naval Intelligence (ONI), an 870member organization providing global IT and classified communications support to shore and deployed assets. His next assignment was with the Office of the Secretary of Defense, serving as Executive Assistant to the Deputy Principal Cyber Advisor. He was then appointed as the Navy Cybersecurity Safety (CYBERSAFE) Director under the Office of the CNO, providing maximum assurance of survivability and resiliency for the Fleet's critical warfighting systems. In Oct 2018, he deployed to North Africa as a security sector reform advisor with the United Nations Support Mission in Libya (UNSMIL). Upon his return in 2019, he was assigned to the Office of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and served as Deputy Director for Intelligence and then as the Intelligence Ops Division Chief, overseeing current operations, crisis response planning and continuity of operations.

CAPT Angel has earned the Information Warfare Officer Pin, Surface Warfare Officer Pin, and Army Parachutist Badge. His awards include the Director of Naval Intelligence Layton Award for Outstanding Leadership, the Naval Intelligence Professionals/Navy League Award for Exceptional Leadership in Operational Intelligence Support to the Fleet, and various unit and personal awards.
